Rocklea Palms Motel was built in the early 1970s as single men's quarters with communal bathroom facilities. With today's mining employment strategies, many of the personnel are engaged on a fly in - fly out basis, thus requiring accommodation for short-term stays. The project involved the complete refurbishment of three blocks of accommodation units.

The buildings were provided with new external balconies, re-roofed and fully painted internally and

externally. Each of the three blocks consists of 55 individual units and the contract works included providing ensuite facilities in each room, air-conditioning, wardrobes, desks and data / telephone connections.

Final landscaping works finished off a remarkable transformation of the tired and dated buildings into high quality modern accommodation.
